BE IT RESOLVED THAT permission is granted to Southern Construction (1981) Ltd. to construct a temporary access road to conduct a Level II Groundwater Assessment with the following conditions:

- A copy of the Licence to Construct from Crown Lands must be forwarded to the Town;
- The road shall be temporary in nature and shall be a maximum of 4.0 metres in width;
- During construction, the contractor shall keep minimal ground disturbance and maintain tree cover;
- The temporary road shall follow the route of the concept plan included on the application;
- Should the Crown Land application be denied, the developer shall restore the area as close to its original condition as possible including the restoration/decommissioning of any test wells;
- The contractor shall obtain any other necessary permits (i.e. water resources, NL Power, forestry, etc.);
- The Crown and/or the Town shall not be responsible for any expenditures incurred by the contractor, regardless of the outcome of the Level II Groundwater study. It is an investment risk of the developer to determine if the land applied for can accommodate their proposal.
